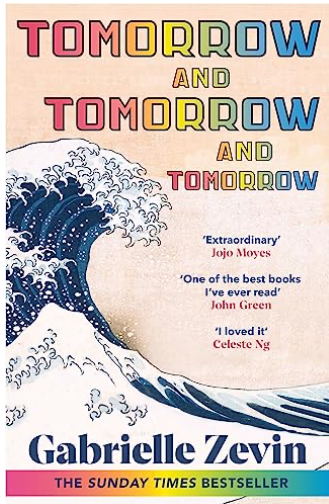


Tomorrow and Tomorrow and Tomorrow
