


Book Talk

The Yacoubian Building

Set in Cairo in the early 1990s, the book follows different characters living in the Yacoubian Building, a formerly luxurious and prestigious apartment block that now houses a more diverse population.

The book looks at how Egyptian society changed over decades, covering attitudes towards class, women, homosexuality and religion.

Originally written in Arabic, it was made into an Egyptian film and TV series.

We recommend this book if you enjoyed *A Gentleman in Moscow* by Amor Towles, or *A Thousand Splendid Suns* by Khaled Hosseini.
